Eligibility

- Restricted to full-time students matriculated at member schools of the **New York Six** Liberal Arts Consortium who are good academic standing;
- Students can enroll for Hindi language instruction at Syracuse University (SU) *only if* the class is not available on their own campus;
- Only Hindi language classes are open to NY6 students through this agreement; all other SU courses are excluded.

Registration

- Registration is handled through the student's home Registrar's office. See newyork6.org for **Cross-Registration Form** or contact your registrar's office for more information;
- Availability of classes cannot be guaranteed;
- Drop/add is administered through SU's Registrar's Office.

Cross-Registration Details

The **New York Six** Cross-registration option is made possible by an agreement between Syracuse University ("Institution of Instruction") and the **New York Six** participating institutions ("Recipient Institutions").

Academic Calendar

The Hindi course follows SU's academic calendar, including semester start and end dates, breaks, and the final examination.

Academic Record and Grades

- The instructor at SU determine students grades;
- The course must be taken for a letter grade (not Pass/Fail);
- Final grades are transmitted from SU to the Registrar at the student's institution. Grades are recorded on the students' home campus transcript, per the home institution's policy;
- SU issues a transcript to each student's Registrar's office;
- The Recipient Institutions accept transcripts issued by SU for credit transfer purposes;
- The grade may or may not be applied to the student's GPA, depending on the terms of the Recipient Institution's policy for courses taken as part of this agreement;
- Please contact your Registrar's Office for further information.

Academic Regulations

- Students enrolled are subject to the academic regulations of Syracuse University, including those for attendance, academic integrity, grading (including incompletes), and deadlines for completion of all coursework;
- SU may dismiss students if they are found to have violated the Syracuse University Code of Conduct;
- A student's home institution is responsible for providing disability accommodations provided under the agreement on their campus. The home institution will coordinate with SU if accommodations are requested by the student.

Fees and Billing

- NY6 students enrolled in shared Hindi courses per this Agreement are not charged tuition for credits taken at Syracuse University;
- Course fees, if any, will be collected directly from students by SU;
- Students should check with their home campus to ensure that they are registered for a full load so as not to compromise any access to financial aid.
